



## Have You Declared It?

Many common items used everyday in the home or workplace may seem harmless, however, when transported by the air, they can be very dangerous. In flight, variations in temperature and pressure can cause items to leak, generate toxic fumes or start a fire.

Please declare if you have any of these dangerous goods in your package:

- **Explosives:** fireworks, flares, sparklers
- **Flammable liquids & solids:** fuel, lighters, refills, paints, matches, e-cigarettes
- **Toxic substances:** acids, poisons, bleach, drain cleaners, solvents
- **Gases:** camping gas, portable gas stove
- **Weapons:** firearms, ammunition, gun-powder, mace, tear gas, pepper spray
- **Pressure containers:** spray cans, butane fuel, scuba tanks, propane tanks, CO<sub>2</sub> cartridges
- **Batteries:** lithium metal batteries, lithium ion batteries, wet cell batteries
- **Other hazardous materials:** dry ice, asbestos, adhesives
- **Radioactive materials**
- **Magnetized materials**
- **Infectious substances**

Failure to declare may be an offence and may result in prosecution.
